

# UK business support during Coronavirus pandemic

Type of support	The details
VAT	Deferral - you can defer VAT due between 20.03 and 30.06 – but you must clear the debt by April 2021.
SSP	Rebate - businesses with less than 250 employees* can claim a rebate for staff paid SSP for 2 weeks. *definition of 'employees' TBC
Job Retention Scheme	For laid-off & furloughed workers - Government will pay 80% of the wages (capped at a max of £2,500 per month) if a business decides to “furlough” any of their workers (company directors are not eligible).
Business Interruption Loan Scheme	By British Business Bank - Interest free loans for the first six months, underwritten by government. Available if your business has a turnover under £45m per annum. Maximum loan value of £5m.
Small Business Grant	For businesses that receive small business rate relief - Your local authority will write to you if you are eligible for this. The grant is to a value of £10,000.
Time to Pay Scheme	For those with outstanding tax liabilities - for UK businesses that pay tax/VAT to HMRC, you may be able to come to an arrangement with HMRC. You can call HMRC on 0800 0159 559
Self-Assessment Delay	For the self-employed - payments due at the end of July 2020 can now be deferred until 31 January 2021. You do not need to apply – this is just automatic.
